THE SOLUTION TO A PERMANENT AND LASTING PEACE IN THE MIDDLE EAST AND THE WORLD.

Aloha Angela and Matthew!

I am a Jewish man born on April 2, 1948 at 8:38 am in Chicago, Illinois.

This letter is in response to a story that both of you wrote that appeared in the *Maui News* on January 16, 2017. There **is** a permanent and lasting solution for peace in the Middle East, peace between Israel and Palestine, peace around the world, an independent Palestinian state, and a "two state solution" which is "threatened" because of nationalist views and a purely material, political viewpoint and perspective which distorts both Israel's and Palestine's "commitment to pursuing a peace deal."

Israeli Foreign Ministry spokesman Emmanuel Nahshon said: "A big show (Mid-east peace conference in Paris) is no replacement for direct negotiations between the parties." French President Francois Hollande said: "It is not a question of dictating to the parties...only direct negotiations between Israeli's and Palestinians can lead to peace. No one will do it in their place. The world cannot, should not resign itself to the status quo."

Chief Palestinian representative to France, Salman Elherfi "insisted that 'the option of two states is not the dream of a single country, but it has become the concern of the world to protect it. Palestinian officials hope the (Paris) conference can lay out terms for eventual **negotiations**, notably on **HOW TO SHARE Jerusalem** and the need to stop Israeli settlements..." "The Palestinians and a number of Arab states have not expressed a will for peace," said Serge Klarsfeld..."If it existed and if the Arab world recognized the existence of Israel, we would find the means to solve all the problems very quickly."

There **is** a solution!

The bottom line is both the Israeli's and Palestinian's resolution to a "two state solution" must be done face to face to **mediate** their differences. Success to an Independent Palestine and a "two state solution" can **NEVER** be negotiated because there is nothing to negotiate. Negotiation is no substitution for mediation. Peace between Israel and Palestine is not a business deal.

The solution on "**HOW TO SHARE**" *Jerusalem* goes back to Isaac and Ishmael who both **SHARED** the same father Abraham but had different mothers. From Isaac descended the Jewish nation and from Ishmael the Arab nations. God/Allah is the father of Abraham. Because Abraham is the father to both Isaac and Ishmael they are **UNITED** as **SONS** of the **ONE** father. There should be no disagreement on this.

By the spirit of God/Allah they are united as ONE Hu-man family. The confirmation of this “Oneness” can be found in the *Qur’an Surah XLII 13*: “ He hath ordained for you that religion which we **commanded** unto Noah, and that which we **inspire** in thee Muhammad (peace be upon him) and that which we commended unto Abraham and Moses and Jesus, saying; **establish the religion**, and BE NOT DIVIDED THEREIN...”

What is the “religion” that is supposed to be “established?” It is nothing material. It is not Judaism. It is not Islam. It is not Christianity. It is not Buddhism. It is not Hinduism. It is not Ba’hai. It is not anything. The “religion” is Unity, the absence of division. The *spirit* of Unity. This is what God “**inspired**” in Muhammad (peace be upon him) and is the **inspiration** for the solution to **sharing Jerusalem** and peace in the Middle East and the world.

All of humanity **shares** the same ONE God. There are many religions but there is only ONE God. The solution to the problem of the Jews and the Palestinians and the “two state solution” is simple. Both claim *Jerusalem* as their capital.(the Palestinians claim east Jerusalem). The Jews believe *Jerusalem* and Israel to be scripturally God given, plus the historical and Biblical fact that the original temple of Solomon stood where the Dome of the Rock now stands and the Western Wall is the remnant of the old temple. Because of these historical truths Israel will never concede to giving up physical possession of *Jerusalem*. For Palestine, not having (east) *Jerusalem* as their capital is a deal breaker. The impasse is seemingly impassable.

Or is it?

Jerusalem translates to mean “place of peace” which it will NEVER be if only a political solution through negotiation is sought. Neither the Jews nor the Palestinians can ever hope to possess (eternally) the physical, material, geographical place called *Jerusalem* because what each nation seeks cannot ever be materially and physically possessed in peace while the other side claims it as *their* capital. This leads to perpetual division. Islam is associated with the word salaam or peace and literally means to submit to the will of God. Islam and Jerusalem both mean peace. Is this a coincidence or by divine design? It is impossible to wage war in the name of Islam. Only peace can be waged.

The solution is a spiritual one. The true *Jerusalem* each nation seeks is spiritual in nature and lies within the human heart of each Palestinian, each Jew and every person on the planet. Peace is what we all seek. Peace in our homes, peace of mind, peace in our countries, peace between nations and peace on earth. Peace, is unattainable without love, and since God is love, God is unattainable if peace and love are absent from the human heart. Peace will NEVER be achieved anywhere, ever, without love, one to the other. Nation to nation. Ishmael and Isaac **loved** each other as brothers **sharing** the same father.

What good to forcibly possess a physical, geographical Jerusalem that will (eternally) cause hatred and division between the Jews and the Palestinians and unrest in the entire Middle East and around the world? The **only** solution is for the Jews and Palestinians to **SHARE** the physical, material Jerusalem in the spirit of Unity, Understanding and Love of the spiritual *Jerusalem* as the “place of peace.” We are ONE hu-man family; One hu-man race. We are all inter-connected as ONE. We must learn to live and **love one another** united under the ONE true God of us all. To love is to **SHARE**. This is the solution to **share Jerusalem**. This is the solution for a permanent and lasting peace in the Middle east and the world.

“Then, one of them, which was a lawyer, asked him a question, tempting him, and saying” ‘Master, which is the great **commandment** in the law?’ Jesus said unto him, thou shalt love thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind. This is the first and great **commandment**, (“He hath **ordained** for you, Muhammad, (peace be upon him) that religion which we **commanded** unto Noah...”)and the second is like unto it. **Thou shalt love thy neighbor as thy self. On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets.”**

The Jews and the Palestinians are “neighbors.” Division cannot exist when you “love thy neighbor”; and, if you “love thy neighbor as thyself” this is the highest expression of Unity. You can throw everything else out the window. “All the law”, that is, all universal and cosmic laws and all of hu-man’s laws are bound up in the first two commandments. This is the only solution to peace in the Middle East.

“Be not divided” is the “religion.” The “commandment” to “love thy neighbor” is “like unto the first commandment” to “love God with all thy heart, mind and soul.” This is the secret to peace. We must all honor His **commandments**. We cannot claim to love God if we do not love our neighbor with “all, our heart, mind and soul.” It is that it is.

The *Qur’an* exhorts us “to **be not divided.**” ***This*** is the great commandment that will unite Israel, Palestine and the world to end the division between peoples. ***THIS*** is “HOW TO SHARE *JERUSALEM.*” This is highly symbolic as God intended for every human being to come to *the spiritual place* in their heart that is *Jerusalem*. The “place of peace.” To come to Islam; to come to peace.

Spiritual *Jerusalem* represents the “*Kingdom of God.*” This transcendence from the material, physical and earthly place *Jerusalem* to the spiritual place *Jerusalem* is the only way to bring about:

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A two state solution WILL bring about Unity because of the ONENESS of the sons of Abraham and the commandment to “*be not divided.*” The Jews and the Palestinians and both factions of the Palestinians must unite as ONE and a united Palestine must truly acknowledge in their hearts’ Israel’s eternal right to exist in God’s plan for humanity in His *Intelligent Design*. If the Palestinians want to exist themselves as an independent state, they must, sincerely, in their hearts, out of love and the brotherhood of man recognize Israel’s right to exist in peace and harmony. There is nothing to negotiate. Forgiveness for each other is in order. We must all forgive ourselves for any trespasses against our human family. And, we must forgive those who have trespassed against us. Forgiveness is the only way for all of humanity to move forward. If not, pride will precede the fall.

Israel must stop their expansion of settlements and learn to spiritually and physically co-exist in love and harmony with their blood cousins and spiritual brothers and sisters. The expansion of settlements is only fueling the fire of further division and hatred in the global community against Israel. This is not sustainable. There is no political solution. There must be a deep seated spiritual recognition that all of humanity is inter-connected, inextricably intertwined as ONE people under God. There must be a true, heartfelt, and mutual “will for peace.”

There is only one thing missing from this scenario for a resolution to the “two state solution.” Who will mediate it? There needs to be a genuine, sincere and heartfelt reconciliation between the Jews and Palestinians. Since this is not a political issue there is no political figure that can mediate the situation. A mediator is a peacemaker. There are no deals to negotiate. The Palestinians and the Jews must recognize they are related by blood and worship the same God who is carefully monitoring the situation.

I Timothy 2:5. “For there is One God and one mediator between God and mankind, the man Christ Jesus.” Please take note that this verse does not say the man Jesus “Christ”. Christ is not a person. It is an energy and a God given office that vibrates, i.e. resonates at the frequency and rate of Love, God or Christ consciousness. There is no such person as Jesus “Christ.” Jesus achieved the Christ vibration which is inherent in the heart of every human being and is just waiting to be activated by you. It’s your choice.

Qur’an: Surah II 87-88: “And verily We gave unto Moses the Scripture and We caused a train of messengers to follow after him, and We gave unto Jesus, son of Mary, clear proofs (of Allah’s sovereignty), and **We supported him with the Holy Spirit.** Is it ever so, that when there cometh to you a messenger (from Allah) with that which ye yourselves desire not, ye grow arrogant, and some ye disbelieve and some ye slay? And they say, Our hearts are hardened. Nay, but Allah cursed them for their disbelief.”

Surah II 136: “Say (O Muslims), We believe in Allah/God and that which is revealed unto us and that which was revealed unto Abraham and Ishmael, and Isaac and Jacob, and the tribes, and that which Moses and Jesus received, and that which the Prophets received from their Lord. **We make no distinction between any of them,** and unto Him we have surrendered.”

The *Holy Qur’an* has established:

- 1) Jesus is supported with the holy spirit.
- 2) God makes no distinction between Abraham, Ishmael, Isaac, Jacob, the tribes of Israel, Moses and Jesus and what was revealed to them. The religion of Unity and Oneness.

Surah II 253. “Of those messengers, some of whom we have caused to excel others, and of whom Allah spoke, while some of them He exalted (above others) in degree: and We gave Jesus, son of Mary, clear proofs (of Allah’s sovereignty) and We supported him with the holy spirit. And if Allah had so willed it, those who followed after them would not have fought one with another **after the clear proofs had come unto them.** But they differed, some of them believing and some disbelieving. And if Allah had so willed it, they would not have fought one with another, but Allah doeth what He will.”

In this verse the focus is on Jesus alone as an exalted messenger of God who was “supported with the Holy Spirit” who received “clear proofs” that the “religion” was Unity, Oneness, and Love. The absence of division.

The next verse from the *Qur'an*, *Surah V. 72* is crucial because it clarifies God telling Muhammad (peace be upon him) the true identity of Jesus and his role as Messiah. V.72: "They surely disbelieve who say, Lo! Allah/God is the Messiah, son of Mary. The Messiah (Jesus himself) said, 'O'children of Israel, worship Allah(God) my Lord and your Lord.' Lo! Whoso ascribeth partners unto Allah hath forbidden paradise. His abode is the Fire. For evil-doers there will be no helpers."

1). Jesus is **not** God. God is God. Jesus worships God. His God and your God.

When Jesus was arrested by the Jewish religious authorities for blasphemy, a capital offense punishable by death, Jesus referred to himself as "**A**" Son of God, not "**the**" Son of God, and clarified this point by quoting *Psalms 82:6*. "I said, 'You are "Gods"; you are all sons of the Most High.'" Another interpretation is: "Thus says the Lord, Ye are Gods and children of the Most High."

But there are those who "disbelieve."

2,000 years ago the material world perspective was so pervasive it was impossible for the Jewish religious authorities to see the truth right before their very eyes. They were "willfully blind and deaf."

2) The *Qur'an* accepts Jesus as the Jewish Messiah.

3) Jesus is the one who will mediate the peace between the Jews and the Palestinians. He is recognized by the Palestinians but not by the majority of Jews who do not accept Jesus as their Messiah.

Surah V. 69. "Lo! Those who believe, and those who are Jews, and Sabaeans and Christians; whosoever believeth in Allah(God) and the Last Day and **doeth right**; there shall be no fear come upon them neither shall they grieve."

Surah V.70. "We made a covenant of old with the children of Israel and **we sent unto them messengers**. As often as a messenger came upon them with that which their souls desired not (they became rebellious). Some (of them), they denied and some they slew." This verse is meant in the context of the Jewish Messiah Jesus. He was the "messenger" "sent unto them" but Jesus did not fit in to their corrupt materialism so they killed (slew) him. The Jews broke the "covenant" that God had ordained for them and Jerusalem was laid waste shortly thereafter..

Surah V.71. "They thought no harm would come of it, (killing the messenger Jesus) so they were willfully blind and deaf. And afterward, Allah turned (in mercy) toward them. Now, (even after that) are many of them willfully blind and deaf. Allah (God) is seer of what they do."

The next verse belongs right here after the others because it is a direct reprimand by God to the Jews. God knows what they did and they thought what they did had no consequences because they were "willfully blind and deaf," arrogant, filled with hubris, pride, and spiritually blind but religiously proud, and "pride goeth before the fall" and Jerusalem fell(from the grace of God) and was wiped out by the Romans.

The Jews brought this upon themselves. They were enslaved in Egypt for not obeying God and taken into captivity in Babylon for the very same reason. The “chosen people” is a two edged sword. Blessed when they follow the commandments and cursed when they don’t listen to God. They are “chosen” to demonstrate to humanity **what not to do and the consequences for not doing it**. The Jewish nation is now in a similar situation and if Israel remains “willfully blind and deaf” there may be cosmic consequences like history past.

Surah V.68. “Say; O’ people of the Scripture;(the Jews) Ye have naught (nothing) (of guidance) till ye observe the Torah and the Gospel (of Jesus) and **that which was revealed unto you from your Lord**. (Jesus is the Messiah). That which is revealed unto thee (Muhammad-Peace be upon him) for thy Lord is certain to increase the contumacy (stubborn refusal to obey or comply with authority) and disbelief of many of them. But grieve not for the disbelieving folk.”

God is telling the Jews you have no guidance until you observe the Torah **and** the Gospel because the Old Testament scriptural prophecies were all fulfilled by Jesus as recorded in the “Gospel” of the New Testament. But, the Jews at the time were “willfully blind and deaf” to recognizing their long awaited Messiah had, in fact, come, and they conspired to kill him but they didn’t succeed. This truth has been suppressed for 2,000 years but the *Qur’an* reveals the truth in *Surah IV 157*. This is not blasphemy. The following verse was instrumental in creating the great divide between Islam and the Catholic church resulting in tens of thousands of lives lost in countless battles over hundreds of years between the two ideologies.

Surah IV 157. “...And because of their saying(according to prophecy), We slew the Messiah, Jesus, son of Mary, Allah’s messenger.-**they slew him not nor crucified**, but it *appeared* so unto them; and Lo! Those who disagree concerning it are in doubt thereof; they have no knowledge thereof save pursuit of a conjecture; **they slew him not for certain.**”

Jesus did not die on the cross by crucifixion which is what the verse means. He was crucified but he didn’t die. What did happen is recorded in the *Dead Sea Scrolls* discovered in 1947 in the caves at Qumran by the Dead Sea. The scrolls were written by an ascetic group of Jews called the *Essenes* who lived during the time of Jesus 2,000 years ago. There are many books written about this subject. *The Passover Plot* by eminent Jewish scholar, Dr. Hugh Schoenfield was published in 1965 and tells the story of what happened. *The Dead Sea Scrolls* chronicles the event almost minute by minute and tells the truth; not “fake news.”

It has now been firmly established that the *Qur’an*, received by Muhammad (peace be upon him), from God, recognizes Jesus as the Jewish Messiah and if the Jews would stop being “willfully blind and deaf” and read the “Gospel” as directed by God, they will see for themselves that Jesus fulfilled all the prophecies and is in fact and truth their Messiah, the “messenger” sent by God to the Jews. If there is to be face to face mediation between the parties the mediator needs to be approved by both parties.

The material world is not what it appears to be. Jesus “*appeared*” to die on the cross. That was a very well thought out illusion that fooled everyone except the ones who were in on it. Jesus had a script to follow. The *Psalms* gave him two different scenarios he could play out. One, he could die on the cross, and the other he lives. That is why they are called the Scriptures. It was his **role** in the real life **movie** to make sure everything predicted to happen, happened exactly when it was supposed to happen according to the Old Testament prophecies. All the events were predicted to happen starting as far back as 1,500 years before Jesus was born. What does that tell you about the nature of reality? It’s just a **scripted** movie. Think carefully about this.

Biblical scholars indicate there are 456 prophecies (predictions/determinations) concerning Jesus. What are the laws of probability on just eight (8) being fulfilled?

- 1) The place of the Messiah Jesus’ birth.
- 2) His being preceded by a messenger.
- 3) How he was to enter Jerusalem.
- 4) His betrayal by a friend.
- 5) He would be betrayed for 30 pieces of silver.
- 6) The money would be thrown in God’s house.
- 7) He would be mute before his accusers.
- 8) He would be crucified.

Using the statistical probability in reference to these eight prophecies, we find the chance that any man might have lived down to the present time and fulfilled all eight prophecies is one (1) in ten (10) to the 17th power, or 1 in 100,000,000,000,000,000. To comprehend this, imagine 10 to the 17th power in silver dollars and lay them down on the face of Texas. They will cover the state two feet deep. Now mark one of these silver dollars and stir the whole mass thoroughly all over the state. Blindfold a man and tell him he can travel as far as he wishes, but he must pick up one silver dollar and say this is the right one that has been marked.

What chance would he have of getting the right silver dollar? Just the same chance that each of the individual prophets would have had in writing these eight prophecies and having them all come true in any one man, from their day to the present time, providing they wrote them in their own wisdom.*

*(Peter Stoner, Stan Telchin, *Betrayed*.) The statistical probability of one man fulfilling all 456 prophecies is beyond human comprehension.

#1. *Micah* 5:2 710 BCE: Prophecy/prediction. “But thou, **Bethlehem** Ephratahm though thou be little among the thousands of Judah, yet out of thee shall he come forth unto me that is to be the ruler in Israel; **whose goings forth have been from of old, from everlasting.**”

Matthew 2:1 7 BCE. Prophecy/prediction fulfilled. “Now when Jesus was born in **Bethlehem** of Judaea in the days of Herod the king, behold, there came wise men (astrologers) from the east (Persia/modern day Iran) to Jerusalem.”

#2. *Isaiah 40:3*. 712 BCE. Prophecy/prediction. “**The voice of him that crieth in the wilderness, prepare ye the way of the Lord, make straight** in the desert a highway for our God.”

John 1:22,23. AD 29. Prophecy fulfilled. Then said they unto him, Who art thou that we may give an answer to them that sent us? What sayest thou of thyself? He said, ‘**I am the voice of one crying in the wilderness, make straight the way of the Lord,** as said the Prophet Isaiah.’”

Malachi 4: 5,6. 397 BCE. Prophecy/prediction. “Behold, I will send you **Elija** the prophet before the coming of the great and dreadful day of the Lord. And he shall **turn the heart of the fathers to the children,** and the heart of the children to their fathers, lest I come and smite the earth with a curse.”

Luke 1:13. 7 BCE. Prophecy fulfilled. “But the angel said unto him, fear not Zacharias; for thy prayer is heard; and thy wife Elisabeth shall bear thee a son, and thou shalt call his name John. And thou shall have joy and gladness; and many shall rejoice at his birth. For he shall be great in the sight of the Lord, and shall drink neither wine nor strong drink; and he shall be filled with the Holy Ghost, even from the mother’s womb. And many of the children of Israel shall he turn to the Lord their God. And he shall go before him in the spirit and power of **Elias(Elija), to turn the hearts of the fathers to the children,** and the disobedient to the wisdom of the just; to make ready a people prepared for the Lord.”

#3. *Zechariah 9:9*. 518 BCE. Prophecy/prediction. “Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion! Shout, daughter of Jerusalem! See, your king comes to you, righteous and having salvation, gentle and riding on a donkey, on a **colt**, the foal of a donkey.”

Mark 11:4-9. 33 AD. Prophecy fulfilled. “They went and found a **colt** out in the street, tied at a doorway. As they untied it, some people standing there asked, ‘What are you doing untying that **colt**? They answered as Jesus had told them to, and the people let them go. When they brought the **colt** to Jesus and threw their cloaks over it, he sat on it. Many people spread their cloaks on the road, while others spread branches they had cut in the fields. Those who went ahead and those who followed shouted, ‘Hosanna!’ Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord. Blessed is the coming kingdom of our father David.’”

#4. *Psalms 41:9*. 1047 BCE. Prophecy/prediction. “Yea, mine own familiar friend, in whom I trusted, which **did eat of my bread,** hath lifted up his heel against me.”

Mark 14:18-22. AD 33. Prophecy fulfilled. “Verily I say unto you, one of you which **eateth** with me shall betray me. It is one of the twelve, that dippeth with me in the dish. The *Son of Man* indeed goeth **as it is written of him,** and as they did eat, Jesus took **bread,** and blessed.”

Mark 14:10. AD 33. Prophecy fulfilled. “And Judas Iscariot, one of the twelve, went unto the chief priests, to betray him unto them.”

#5. *Zechariah 11:12. 487 BCE.* Prophecy/prediction. “And I said unto them, if ye think good, give me my price; and if not, forbear. So they weighed for my price **thirty pieces of silver.**”

Matthew 26:15. AD 33. Prophecy fulfilled. “And I said unto them, what will you give me, and I will deliver him unto you? And they covenanted with him for **thirty pieces of silver.**”

#6. *Zechariah 11:13. 487 BCE.* Prophecy/prediction. “And the Lord said unto me cast it unto the **potter**; a goodly price that I was priced at of them. And I took the **thirty pieces of silver** and cast them to the **potter** in the house of the Lord.”

Matthew 27:6,7. AD 33. Prophecy fulfilled. “And the chief priests took the **silver pieces** and said, ‘It is not lawful to put them into the treasury because it is the price of blood.’ “And they took counsel and bought with them the **potter’s** field, to bury strangers in.”

#7. *Isaiah 53:7. 712 BCE.* Prophecy/prediction. “He was oppressed, and he was afflicted, yet, **he opened not his mouth**; he is brought as a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before his shearers is dumb, so **he openeth not his mouth.**”

Matthew 26:62,63. AD 33. Prophecy fulfilled. “And the high priest arose and said unto him, ‘**Answereth thou nothing?** What is it which these witness against thee? But **Jesus held his peace.** And the high priest answered and God said unto him, ‘I adjure thee by the living God, that thou tell us whether thou be the Christ, the Son of God.’”

#8. *Isaiah 53:12. 712 BCE.* Prophecy/prediction. “Therefore will I divide him a portion with the great, and he shall divide the spoil with the strong; because he hath poured out his soul unto death; and he was numbered with the transgressors; and he bare the sin of many, and made intercession for the transgressors.”

Matthew 27:38. AD 33. Prophecy fulfilled. “Then there were two thieves crucified with him, one on the right hand and another on the left.”

Psalms 22:16. 1047 BCE. Prophecy/prediction. “For dogs have compassed me; the assembly of the wicked have enclosed me; they **pierced my hands and feet.**”

Zechariah 12:10. 487 BCE. Prophecy/prediction. “...and they shall look upon me whom they have **pierced...**”

John 20:25 AD 33. Prophecy fulfilled. “But he (Thomas) said unto them, except I shall see in his hands the print of the nails, and put my finger into the print of the nails, and thrust my hand into his side, I will not believe.”

John 20:27. AD 33. Prophecy fulfilled. “Then saith he to Thomas, reach hither thy finger, and behold my hands; and reach hither thy hand, and thrust it into my side; and be not faithless but believing.”

Deuteronomy 18:15. 1451 BCE. Prophecy/prediction. “The Lord thy God will raise up unto thee a Prophet from the midst of thee, of thy brethren, like unto me, unto him ye shall harken; I will raise them up a **prophet** from among their brethren, like unto thee and will put my words in his mouth; and he shall speak unto them all that I shall command him.”

John 6:14. AD 33. Prophecy fulfilled. “Then those men, when they had seen the miracle that Jesus did, said, “This is of a truth, *that* **prophet** that should come unto the world.”

John 7:40. AD 33. Prophecy fulfilled. “Many of the people therefore, when they heard this saying, said, of a truth **this is the prophet.**”

Psalms 110:4. 1004 BCE. Prophecy/prediction. “The Lord hath sworn, and will not repent, thou art a **priest** for ever **after the order of Melchizedek.**”

Hebrews 6:20. Prophecy fulfilled. Exact date unknown possibly around AD 33. “Whether the forerunner is for us entered, even Jesus made a **high priest** for ever **after the order of Melchizedec.**”

Isaiah 9:1,2. 740 BCE. Prophecy/prediction. “Nevertheless the dimness shall not be such as was in her vexation, when at first he lightly afflicted the land of **Zebulun** and the land of **Naphtali**, and afterward did more grievously afflict her **by the way of the sea, beyond Jordan**, in **Galilee of the nations**. The **people who walked in darkness have seen a great light**; they that dwell in the land of **the shadow of death** and unto them hath **the light shined.**”

Matthew 4:12-16. AD 32-33. Prophecy fulfilled. “Now when Jesus had heard that John was cast into prison, he departed unto **Galilee**; and leaving Nazareth he came and dwelt in Capernaum, which is upon the sea coast, in the borders of **Zebulun** and **Nephtalim**; that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Easias/Isaiah, the Prophet, saying, the land of Zabulon, and the land of Nephtalim, **by the way of the sea, beyond Jordan**, Galilee of the Gentiles; the **people which sat in darkness saw great light**; and to them which sat in the region and **shadow of death light is sprung up.**”

There are 456 prophecies that Jesus fulfilled. The ones above are just a few of them. Jesus is the only one qualified to mediate for the Jews and the Palestinians a permanent and lasting peace. But, how can someone who died 2,000 years ago mediate the peace in 2017? The answer can be found in *John 14:1-3* when Jesus said “**I will come again** and receive you unto myself.” and the riddle can be solved by *Matthew 24:32*. The “fig tree” is Israel re-born on May 14, 1948. The disciples asked Jesus for the sign of his return to earth and he said to learn the “parable of the fig tree” as to his “second coming.” Jesus in his reincarnated self will mediate the peace.

Qur’an Surah 2, The Cow verse 28. “How can you make denial of Allah, who made you live **again** when you died, and will make you dead **again**, and then alive **again**, until you finally return to Him.”

Qur’an: “God generates beings, and **sends them back over and over again**, till they return to Him.”

Quran Surah 11, Rome, Verse 38. “God is the one who created you all, then provided you sustenance, then will cause you to die, **then will bring you life.**”

Qur’an. “I tell you, *of truth*, that the spirits which now have affinity shall be kindred together, although **THEY ALL MEET IN NEW PERSONS AND NAMES.**”

Qur’an. Surah V, 171. “People of the book (Torah), do not go to excess in your religion; do not say of God anything but truth. The Messiah, Jesus, son of Mary, was only an envoy of God and a Word of God bestowed on Mary, and a spirit of God.”

Qur’an: “**The person of man is only a mask** which the **soul putteth on for a season**; it weareth its proper time and then is cast off and another is worn in its stead.”

Qur’an Surah 2, the Cow 287. “God does not compel a soul to do what is beyond its capacity; it gets what it has earned and is responsible for what it deserves.” Cause and effect.

Jesus: “What you sow you reap.” Cause and effect.

Qur’an Surah 3, The Family of Imran, verse 30. “Every soul will be brought face to face with the good that it has done and with the evil it has done.”

Qur’an Surah 21, The Prophet verse 47. “And we will set up the scales of justice for the day of reckoning. And no soul shall be wronged in anything. And be it the weight of a mustard seed, We will bring it forth; and We are well able to take account.”

Qur’an Surah 36, Ya Sin, verse 12. “For we give life to the dead, and we record what they sent before and what they left after them; and We have taken account of all things.”
